## **Fountain Grass**

The Big Island Invasive Species Committee is clear that fountain grass presents a critical fire threat on the west side, and recommends "Property owners should control it where possible, as it is too widespread for island-wide control by BIISC. It is also recommended that communities maintain "fuel-breaks," wide areas free of fountain grass, particularly in dry months."

The State of **Hawaii Invasive Species Council** classifies fountain grass as high risk, particularly to the west side of the Big Island.
